Tunghai University Foreign Languages and Literature Department (FLLD) Rules for the 2020 Video Contest for FLLD Students

I. Eligibility:

This contest is open to all students of FLLD.

II. Contest Rules and Topic:

- A. Individual students create a script and make a video. This video has to be between 3 to 5 minutes long and should be in English.
- B. The video must be original work filmed by the students. Students must prepare their own scripts. Outside sources may be used but must be acknowledged.
- C. Topic: The Department of Foreign Languages and Literature focuses on teaching students English, French, German, and Spanish. Reflect on how your life is enriched by learning different European languages and cultures. Consider both the joys and challenges of learning European languages and cultures. Think about experiences in language camps abroad, learning through videos on-line, using songs and lyrics, having a language exchange buddy, etc.
- D. The video may include scenes filmed on location in the FLLD or around campus, but at least 60 % of the video should involve narrative commentary or speech in English.

III. Registration and Contest Details:

- A. Students can enter the contest from 1 to 15 March 2020 by sending an e-mail to mdesmet@thu.edu.tw giving their Chinese name, English name, student number, e-mail address, and video title.
- B. The total number of entries is limited to 25.
- C. Collection of videos: 16 to 31 March 2020. Entries must be received by 5:00 pm on 31 March 2020. E-mail video file or the google drive link to your video to mdesmet@thu.edu.tw by the collection deadline.
- D. Announcement date of winners: 10 April 2020

IV. Scoring Criteria:

30% Content [video concept/design, creativity];

30% English Ability [pronunciation, intonation, fluency, accuracy, word and language choice];

20% Acting/Presentation Style [emotional content, facial expression and body language, loudness];

20% Production Technology [shooting, editing]

V. Judges:

Three FLLD teachers function as judges. They have final authority to determine

winners and reassign prize money, such as in the case of a tie.

VI. Prizes:

- A. 1^{st} prize: NT\$ 3,000; 2^{nd} prize; NT\$ 2,000; 3^{rd} prize: NT\$ 1,000; 4^{th} , 5^{th} and 6^{th} prizes: NT\$ 500.
- B. The winning videos will be uploaded onto the departmental website.
- C. All participants and winners will receive certificates.
