Each abstract should be submitted in Microsoft Word compatible and editable formats (\*.doc or \*.docx) and will be double-blindly reviewed by three professional reviewers. The accepted abstracts should be presented in the conference, and the full paper may later be published in *Chien Hsin Journal of Applied Foreign Language Studies* (ISSN 2220-1742).

## Conference paper topics may include, but are by no means limited to:

- 1. English for specific purposes (ESP)
- 2. Literary studies applied in TESL or ESP
- 3. Teaching English, Japanese or other foreign languages as a second language
- 4. Interdisciplinary studies on languages, literature and cultures
- 5. Studies on cultural creative industry
- 6. Translation in English, Japanese or other foreign languages
- 7. Studies on creative writing and language training
- 8. Teaching Chinese as a second language
- 9. Studies on linguistics
